

RULES FOR SKI TOURING ON THE PISTES IN THE SALZBURGER SAALACHTAL

The following rules for behaviour of ski tourers provide the basis for conflict-free cooperation on the ski pistes of the Almenwelt Lofer and in Heutal Unken:

1. Comply with warning signs and local rules.
2. Obey the closure of a piste or part of a piste. Life-threatening situations can arise when piste groomers, particularly those with cable winches, are in operation or during avalanche blasting etc. Pistes can therefore be closed for safety reasons for the duration of the work.
3. Only ascend at the edge of the piste and one behind the other.
4. Only cross the piste at places where you can be seen clearly and with sufficient distance between you.
5. Only ski at the edges of freshly prepared pistes. Tracks which freeze overnight can seriously reduce the quality of the pistes.
6. Ski touring is only permitted during the lift operating times.
7. Make yourself visible. In poor visibility use headlamps, reflective clothing etc.
8. Only use the ascent routes/pistes specifically designated for ski touring. For ascent routes Almenwelt Lofer, see <http://bit.ly/2jN0455>.
9. Do not take dogs with you on the pistes.
10. Ski tourers on the officially designated pistes pay a fee for the use of the car park as well as the preparation of the slopes.
 - Regulations for the Almenwelt Lofer: tickets are available at the cash desk (season tickets and day tickets) and in car park P3 (self-service, day tickets only). Season ticket: € 75, day ticket: € 9.
 - Regulations for Heutal Unken: a parking fee of € 5 is payable in the car park. Touring tickets are available to purchase afterwards at the lift cash desk.
 - Touring Day Ticket per person (parking fee refunded on presentation of the tear-off slip): € 12
 - Touring Season Ticket per person (incl. winter parking ticket Heutal): € 86
